


Our examinations are hosted on the IECA eHub's website. You will need to create an account with them (it is free, you do not have to become a member) in order to purchase the examinations. You can click on the link found on the pages shown above or go directly to the site: https://ehub.ieca.org/CISEC.

You can find our information directly from the eHub page by clicking on "CISEC" found on the left side of the page. Our list of products is found once you have clicked on "Canada" and you can select which examination you are qualified for.

Upon purchase of the examination (see information below on qualifications), you will have access to the registration form (IT, Level 1) or the application and reference form (Full, Level 3 or IT, Level 2).

Full, Level 3 Examination:

- Requires a minimum of two years of work experience in sediment and erosion control
 and/or stormwater pollution prevention field experience. If you are not sure if the
 experience you have would apply, please contact us at examination@ecopliant.org.
- Prior classes, training, and/or other education in sediment and erosion control and/or environmental related topics
- Three references attesting to qualifications and experience (a form can be downloaded from the IECA eHub for references to fill out).
- The above information can be filled out and submitted online through the IECA eHub (after purchase of the examination). The reference form is found on the Application Information Tab. The online application and place to submit the references is found on the Contents Tab.



IT, Level 1:

- For those who DO NOT have the minimum two years of work experience in sediment and erosion control and/or stormwater pollution prevention field experience.
- Requires filling out a registration form online at the IECA eHub, which is found on the Contents Tab.
- Upon gaining the two years of experience, a CAN-CISEC-IT will be eligible to take the IT, Level 2 examination and if passes will gain Full Registrant status.



IT, Level 2:

- Is ONLY for those that are current CAN-CISEC-ITs (took and passed the IT, Level 1 and has maintained a current status with CISEC, Inc. through yearly renewals). IT Registrants should verify with the Renewals Department that they are approved to sit for the Level 2 examination).
- Requires a minimum of two years of work experience in sediment and erosion control and/or stormwater pollution prevention field experience. If you are not sure if the experience you have would apply, please contact us at examination@ecopliant.org.
- Prior classes, training, and/or other education in sediment and erosion control and/or environmental related topics
- Three references attesting to qualifications and experience (a form can be downloaded from the IECA eHub for references to fill out).
- The reference form is found on the Application Information Tab. The online application and place to submit the references is found on the Contents Tab.
- If the IT, Level 2 examination is passed, will become a Full Registrant.



After the Examination is purchased:


Once you have purchased the examination through the IECA eHub, Ecopliant Environmental, Inc. will review your information (application, references, registration form) and will send you an email with information for on how to schedule your online proctoring session with ProctorU (separate fee applies and is payable directly to ProctorU at time of scheduling).

Scheduling with ProctorU is setup to meet your needs and is available 24/7. <u>Please make sure to use the link sent in the email to access scheduling of the examination.</u> Our examinations are hidden as they require approval from to schedule.

Once you have taken the examination, we ask for up to 30 days to grade your examination (Full, Level 3 Examination and IT, Level 2 only). For IT, Level 1, we ask for up to 72 hours to process your results. We will send you an email with your results.

If you pass, you will be sent a DocuSign Contract via email for review and electronic signing. This document has information regarding your yearly renewal fees and requirements. Upon Ecopliant Environmental, Inc. receiving the signed DocuSign back, you will be sent via email your registrant number and an electronic wallet card. We will follow up via mail with your Wall Certificate and Logo sticker.

Please note, all registrants are required to renew on a yearly basis [starting one year from the date of your contract (found in the DocuSign documents)]. Please visit our renewal pages for more information or contact the Renewals Department (cdh renewals@ecopliant.org).
